### #2 Are all windows NFRC rated?

Most sunroom windows come with an Energy Star rating, but the less common is the National Fenestration Ratings Council testing for national building code compliance.

# #3 Are all the windows made to custom sizes?

Sunrooms are best when they maximize the area of glass within the walls. To do this, the windows should be custom sized, but many companies use standard window sizes with opaque filler on the edges to occupy empty space.



#### What materials will my sunroom be made out of?

Nearly all sunrooms are made of either vinyl, aluminum, or vinyl-clad aluminum. Ask what material reinforces the structure of your room to understand how insulated it will be. The highest performance structures are made of Fibreglass and Vinyl. Aluminum is cheaper, but less efficient.



# $\#5 \quad \begin{array}{l} \mbox{Will screw heads and other fasteners be} \\ \mbox{visible from inside and outside the room?} \end{array}$

Some sunrooms are engineered to conceal screws and other unsightly fasteners within the window frames, but most are made with dozens of exterior screws drilled directly into the structure.

# Will my room be custom-designed, or made with a preset kit?
